

2020 Application and Registration Information:

The deadline for applications for the Summer Vocology Institute (SVI) is **March 1, 2020**. International students requiring visas to study in the US are advised to begin the registration process as soon as possible to take care of the necessary paperwork. An application packet* for the Summer Vocology Institute must include the following:

1. A completed registration form: Please fill out, sign, and date (form provided below).
2. A resume: Include educational and professional experiences. Any professional honors, publications, or presentations should be noted as well.
3. A transcript: Please submit your most recent degree program.
4. Three letters of recommendation: It is best to have these done by a professor or an overseer at your work. They may be sent under separate cover or by email.
5. A statement of past experiences and professional goals: Although the format will vary from individual to individual, these personal statements should include summaries of previous professional and educational experiences that were of a concentrated nature similar to the SVI as well as a description of how the SVI will facilitate attainment of future goals.

Applications received after March 1 will be reviewed on a space-available basis. The registration packet may be emailed, faxed, or mailed. We still have your other packet materials on file. <i>Please indicate that you are returning student in your email to submit.</i></p>	<p>Credit, tuition and fees: Graduate credit will be given by the University of Utah through both the departments of Music and Communication Sciences and Disorders as contracted continuing education credits. The courses are the same and the department you choose to register through is entirely personal preference of how you want the credits to show up on your transcript. Students seeking to have these credits transferred to another educational institution must make these arrangements in advance through your institution. Tuition rate for 2020 is \$450 per credit hour for all students applying.*</p> <p>*University of Utah students must pay the regular graduate tuition rate as stated in their degree program of choice.</p>
